

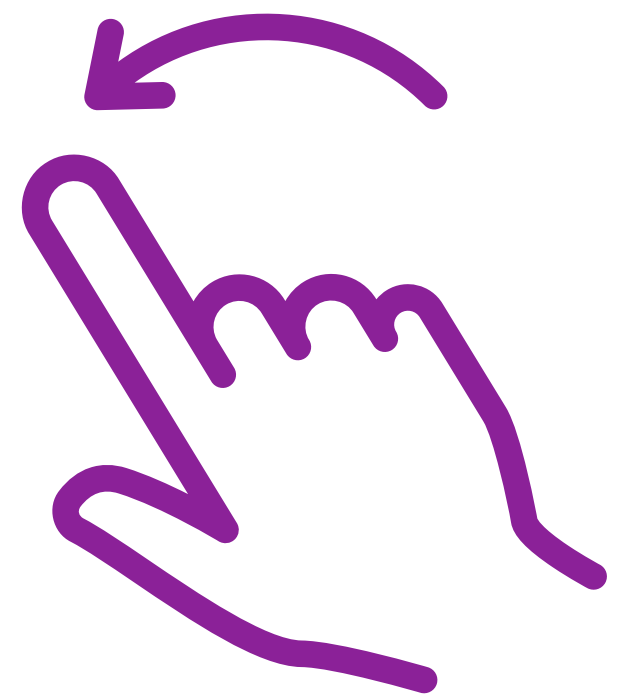


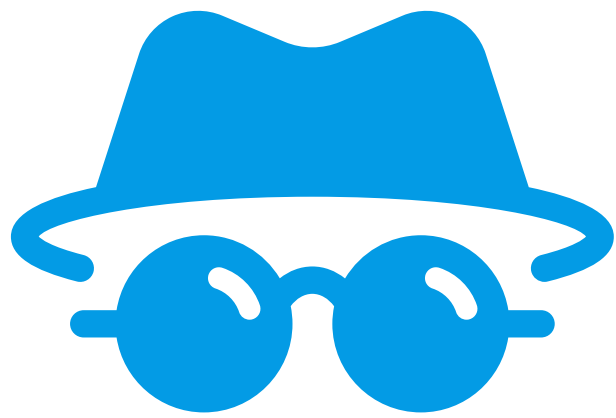

Incognito Mode...

When you browse privately or enter 'incognito mode', your web browser **does not store your browsing history, cookies, site data, or other personal information**, providing a level of privacy and anonymity.

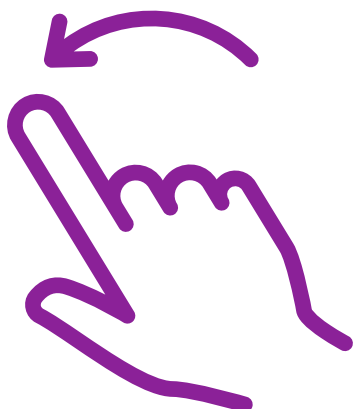
This can help you **protect your privacy**, avoid unwanted ads, and access content that might be blocked by your network or location.

Opening on Different Devices

- On Windows or Mac, you can use the keyboard shortcut Ctrl+Shift+N (also for Chrome, Opera, or Edge)
- Ctrl+Shift+P (for Firefox or Safari) to open a new private window.
- You can also click on the menu icon (usually three dots or lines) on the top right corner of your browser and select to open a new private window, this would be the case when browsing on Android or IOS.

In Google Chrome

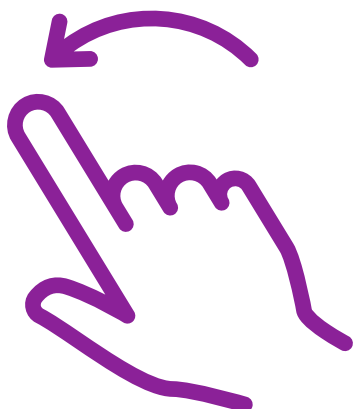
1. Open Chrome.
2. At the top right, click the menu icon (three dots).
3. Select New incognito window.
4. A new window will appear with a grey incognito icon in the top right corner.
5. You can also use the keyboard shortcut `Ctrl+Shift+N` to open a new incognito window.

In Microsoft Edge

1. Open Edge.
2. At the top right, click the menu icon (three dots).
3. Select New InPrivate window.
4. A new window will appear with a blue InPrivate icon in the top left corner.
5. You can also use the keyboard shortcut Ctrl+Shift+N to open a new InPrivate window.

In Internet Explorer

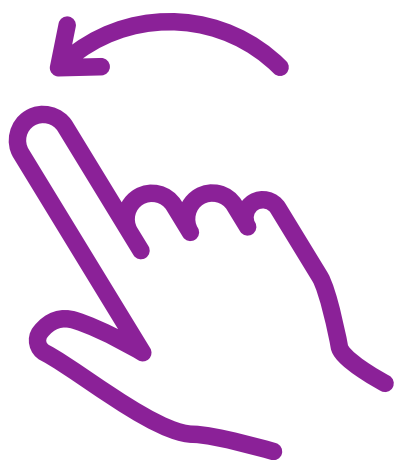
1. Open Internet Explorer.
2. At the top right, click the menu icon (gear icon).
3. Select Safety and then InPrivate Browsing.
4. A new window will appear with a blue InPrivate icon in the address bar.
5. You can also use the keyboard shortcut Ctrl+Shift+P to open a new InPrivate window.

In Opera

1. Open Opera.
2. At the top right, click the menu icon (O icon).
3. Select New window with VPN.
4. A new window will appear with a blue VPN icon in the address bar.
5. You can also use the keyboard shortcut `Ctrl+Shift+N` to open a new window with VPN.

In Mozilla Firefox

1. Open Firefox.
2. At the top right, click the menu icon (three lines).
3. Select New Private Window.
4. A new window will appear with a purple mask icon in the top right corner.
5. You can also use the keyboard shortcut `Ctrl+Shift+P` to open a new private window.
